This amazing project's vision is to provide quality health services starting with the local community, mostly from villages of Wilson, Mukuonda, Tera, Chagowo and Chiweyu of T/A Malenga Mzoma in Nkhatabay, extending to the whole district.

Local plumber Danny Bill, with a team of Pembrokeshire people, passionately support this project, using their skills and resources to work with the team in Malawi. He and the team are currently waiting to send a container from UK with medical equipment and a Medical Certificate from the Ministry of Health to the clinic.

The programme is funded by money raised across churches and groups in Pembrokeshire and the UK, supporting **Links International**. They shall continue until they are able to sustain themselves.

Previously there was only 1 clinic to 22,000 people. After the Board of trustees met, it was agreed that services should be provided where charges should be easily affordable to the local people. They currently employ a team of Malawi people, including a Doctor.

Danny and the team, sometimes against all odds, have used their skills to build toilets and running water, supplying the village and clinic with safe water. Always inspired by faith, Danny gives thanks to God for His provision and goodness; his dedication to this project is truly inspiring and lives are being transformed as a result.

"As we are serving the community spiritually, it is also our stand to help them physically by providing good health facilities". Says Vibitac.
