Later he heard Jesus say that he will be moving around a lot, with no permanent home, away from family and friends.

For the last 6 months he has been visiting Pembrokeshire via a sponsor and he hoped to be financed by finding work here.

His Christian path is just beginning, with Jesus leading the way for him now. We are praying for him, and invite you to pray for him too.
