What if ...

A group of people were free enough to live in a way that, when they met the presence of God was more important than the meeting? The prophets heard from God and shared their treasures with others? The psalmists (singers/musicians) led people into God's Holy of Holies, attracting others there too?

What if ...

Healing, speaking in heavenly tongues, prophesy and discernment were the norm? Sharing life stories was encouraged because it was all happening there – in their: "On earth as it is in heaven" life styles?

The guest speakers could be quizzed about how it all works in their life? Newcomers were assigned a guide to explain everything to them?

What if...

They took God at his word: in prayers, in the way they treated one another, believing God is with them, believing His promises?

What if they broke down the walls of their holy of holies and broke out into the world and met where people are?

What if...

Leaders lived to find the gifts of others, poured their knowledge and experience to disciple (train) others to follow; sending them to places they can not go themselves? Others respected and honoured them, following their lead?

What if ...

Their money and time was handled so no one was ever in need? Offerings covered the everyday running of things, but promised tithes made sure those who, serve are blessed; those in need had their meet the needs met? They knew who the widow, the orphan, the lonely and lost of today?

What if ...

They were honest about failings, weaknesses and strengths? Sharing the Truth with everyone they met, showing them the way?

They were not bias or judgemental to other believers. They were truly united?

What if ...

They dared to be different, change their style, adapted their approach? Didn't mind being asked awkward questions, didn't get defensive?

What if ...

They asked "is this the best there is?", checking if what they are living, believing and practicing is actually what God wants – and dared to make the changes needed? They strove for the best the past has ever offered and lived in what God is saying to the Church today? They let Jesus take the driving seat of their lives, families and fellowship?

What if they did nothing? Could they cope with the regret?

What if WE thought that this was worth discussing, acting on – even only one point? Would it make a difference?
